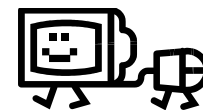




# FUTURE TENSE



## BILL OF RIGHTS

“The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.”

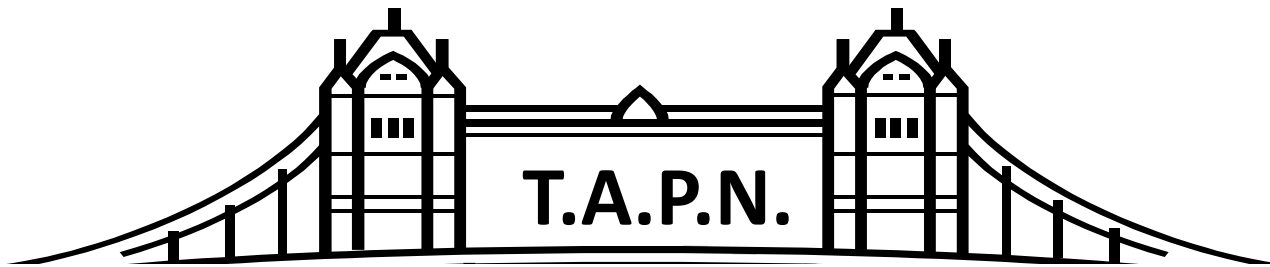


# ATTORNEY GENERAL'S ELDER ABUSE COMMISSION

## A BILL

To amend sections 2317.54, 5101.60, 5101.61, 5101.611, 5101.62 to 5101.64, 5101.66 to 5101.71, 5101.72, 5101.99, 5123.61, and 5126.31; to amend, for the purpose of adopting new section numbers as indicated in parentheses, sections 5101.61 (5101.63), 5101.611 (5101.64), 5101.62 (5101.65), 5101.63 (5101.652), 5101.64 (5101.66), 5101.65 (5101.68), 5101.66 (5101.681), 5101.67 (5101.682), 5101.68 (5101.69), 5101.69 (5101.70), 5101.70 (5101.71), 5101.71 (5101.61), and 5101.72 (5101.611); and to enact new sections 5101.62 and 5101.67 and sections 5101.631, 5101.651, 5101.701, and 5101.702 of the Revised Code to revise the laws governing the provision of adult protective services.

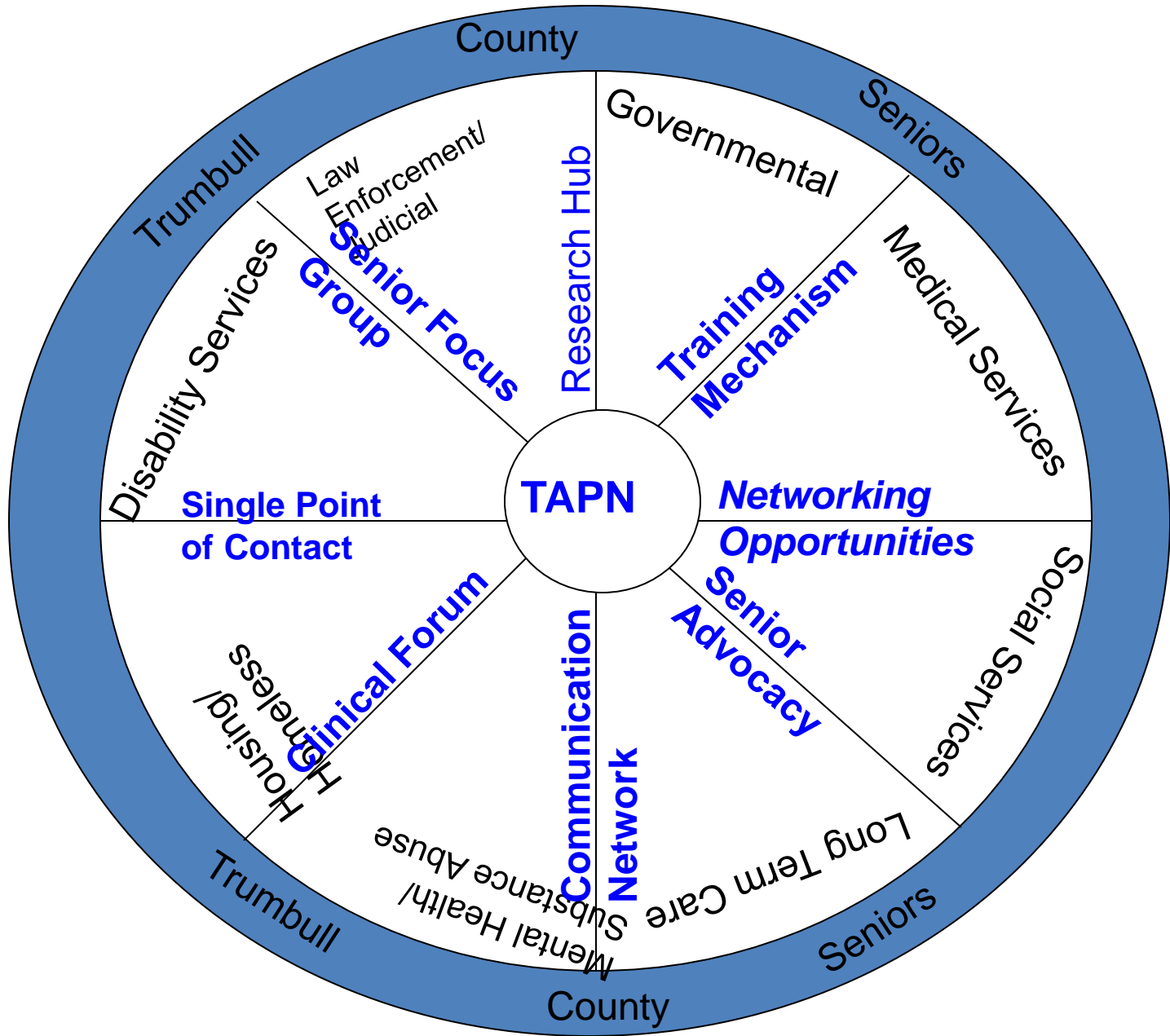
## TAPN - Trumbull Advocacy and Protective Network

### TAPN is...

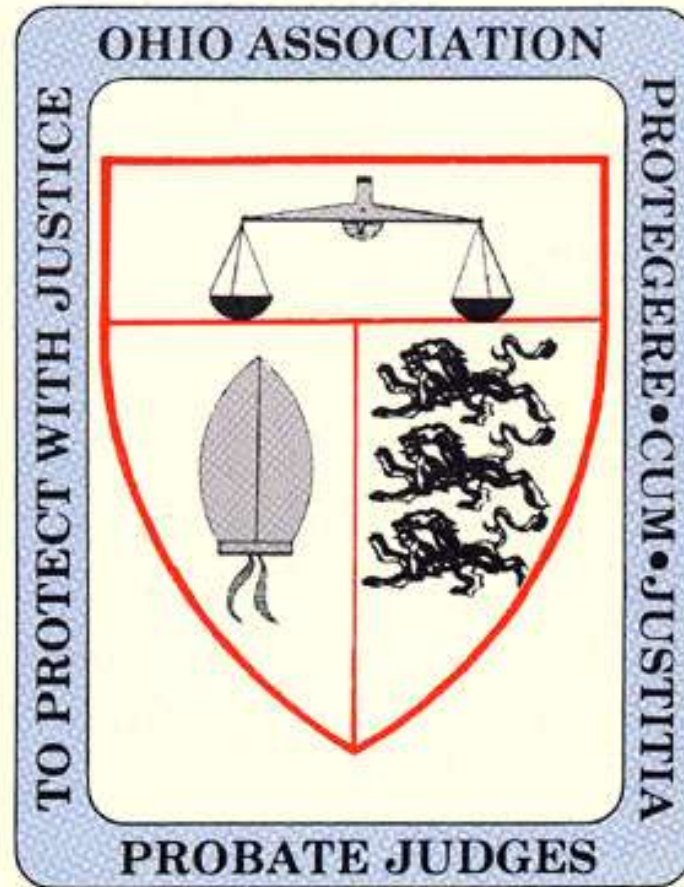
A network of Trumbull County representatives from social services, government, medicine, law enforcement, the courts and others who serve seniors and share a common desire to provide...

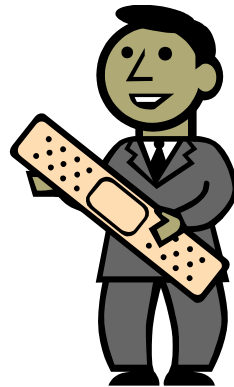


# Transfer of Adult Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act

A BILL

To amend section 2111.02, to enact sections 2112.01, 2112.011, 2112.02, 2112.03, 2112.04, 2112.05, 2112.21, 2112.22, 2112.23, 2112.24, 2112.25, 2112.26, 2112.27, 2112.31, 2112.32, 2112.41, 2112.42, and 2112.43, and to repeal section 2111.41 of the Revised Code to adopt the Transfer of Adult Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act.

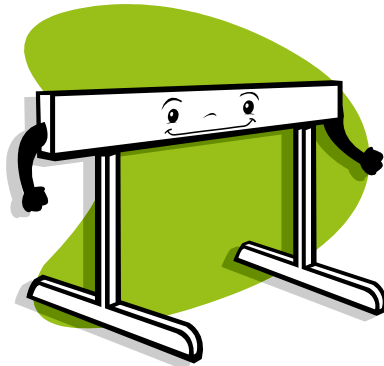

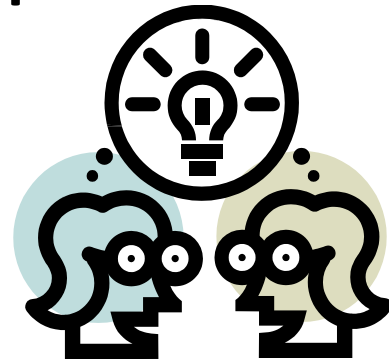
# Mission Statement

- To seek solutions that would preserve the dignity and legal rights of those 60 years of age and older, while considering the needs and safety of the entire community.



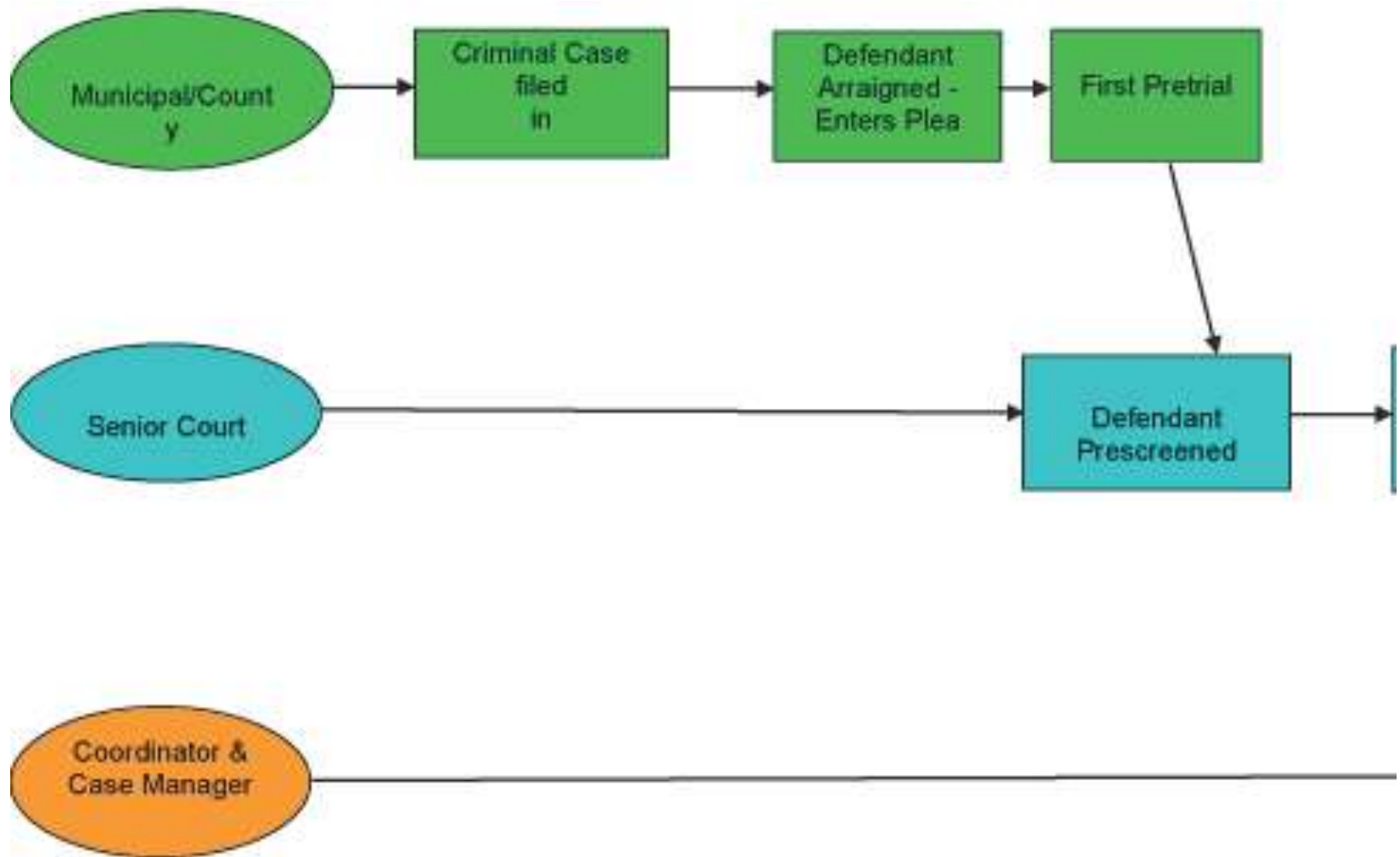
# What will Senior Court do?

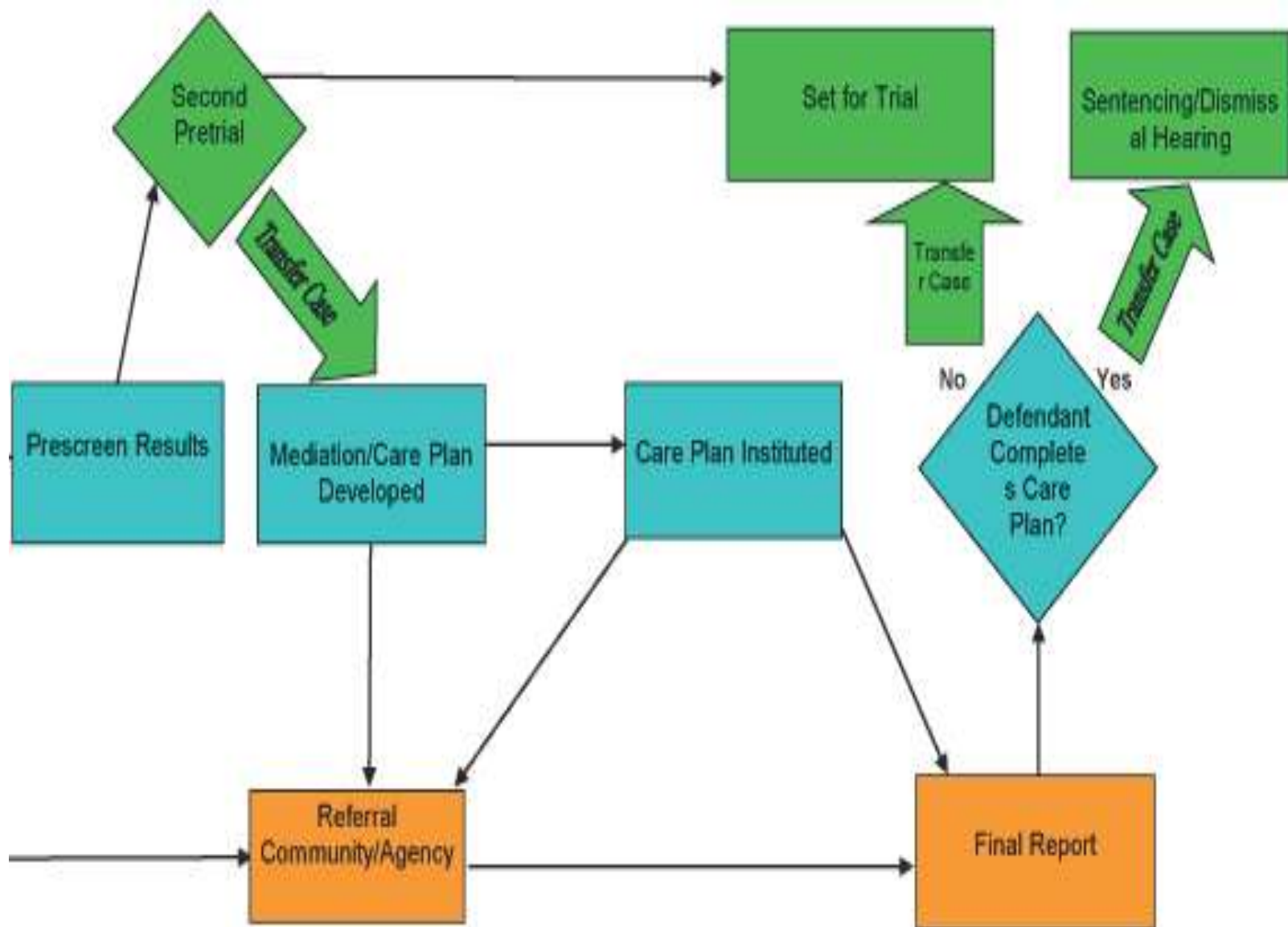
- The Senior Court will establish an elder friendly court to provide solutions to legal issues faced by those 60 years of age and older due to mental or physical impairments or diminished capacities.
