

How Did We Get Here?

- The Ohio Commission to Reform Medicaid
- The Ohio Medicaid Administrative Study Council

Addressed the need for a unified budget.



The Process

- The Governor appointed 23 members.
- Legislative leadership appointed four members of the General Assembly to the workgroup.
- The plan was completed on June 1, 2008,
- Five subcommittees (300+ people) assisted the workgroup.
- The workgroup and subcommittees held 94 meetings over 10 months.
